MINUTES

1. Call to Order – Chairman Kyle Stumbris called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Committee members present were Jason Figas, Bradley Taylor and Hilbert Radtke. Also in attendance were Clerk Toshia Ranallo and Street Supervisor Darryll Schmidt.
2. Approval of Agenda – J. Figas made a motion seconded by Taylor to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – Review 5 Year Street Improvement Plan. – After reviewing the 5 year street improvement plan, it was decided to obtain quotes to reconstruct Orlando Drive to Butternut Avenue and get a quote from Marinette County to extend the work they are doing on County C from Hillside road west to the Village limits.
4. Discussion – Create a plan to prevent flooding on Cedar Street. – The ditch by Lois Dunn’s driveway will be dug out and a load of patching material will be brought in to build up the area which will make the water flow to the south.
5. Discussion – Create a plan for winter parking. – Residents that do not have a driveway will be sent a letter to inform them they will have to park on the right side of the street on even days of the month and on the left side of the street on odd days. The committee also discussed the procedure for writing citations.
6. Discussion – Review Memo from Highway Commissioner to complete a Bridge Aid Application. – The committee reviewed the letter and decided to take no action.
7. Adjourn – J. Figas made a motion seconded by Taylor to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 p.m. Motion carried.
