**MINUTES**

1. Call to Order – President Radtke called the meeting to order at 1:45 pm. Committee members in attendance were Bradley Taylor, Ray Gordon, and Mack McKim. Also in attendance were Treasurer/Interim Clerk Sara Pullen and Streets Supervisor Dennis Whitton, Jr.
2. Approval of Agenda – Taylor made a motion seconded by Gordon to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – Review 5 year street improvement plan. – The Committee members toured the Village streets to evaluate the current conditions and determine if any revisions should be made to the current 5 year street improvement plan. The Committee will make the following recommendations to the Board:
  - a. Tyler Ave., Harrison Ave., Van Buren Ave., and Monroe Ave. – The Committee would like to see all of these streets from the Hwy west to First Street milled and repaved in conjunction with the Hwy project; Board needs to determine priority.
  - b. Faxton St. and Polk Ave. from Division St. west to Village limits – Mill and apply recycled asphalt on both streets in 2016. Milling to be in conjunction with the milling of the detour route.
  - c. Faxton St. – Seal coated in 2017.
  - d. Polk Ave. east to Tyler Ave. – Chip seal; Board needs to determine priority.
  - e. Van Buren Ave., Milwaukee Ave., Marinette Ave., Monroe Ave., Church St., and Poplar St. – Chip seal and crack fill; Board needs to determine priority.
  - f. Evergreen Park entrance (by filling station) – Crack seal as needed.
  - g. Fairgrounds Rd. – Chip seal from Town limits west to the intersection at Cedar Street; Board needs to determine priority.
  - h. North Ave. – This was a certified detour route during the bridge reconstruction project and is currently a certified detour route for the current highway reconstruction project. The Committee feels that this route should be replaced by the state in 2017 when they reconstruct the south bound detour route.
  - i. Oak St. and Grove Ave. – These streets are on the 5 year replacement plan schedule to be repaved in 2018.

The Committee asked Dennis to schedule a meeting with Pat from Scott Construction to review the above revisions to the 5 year street improvement plan and provide the Village with a listing of his recommendations (priority order) as they apply to the plan changes.

The Committee discussed Monroe Avenue's planned reconstruction from the Hwy east to Merrill Street for 2016. President Radtke stated that the Village was awarded \$10,000 out of Marinette County's 2016 -2017 MSILT program entitlement. Pullen will check on

the status of this award and whether or not the Village needs to proceed with the reconstruction of Monroe in 2016 or if it can wait until 2017.

4. Discussion – Public parking alternatives. – The Committee visited several locations for potential off-street parking. They did not compile a list of recommendations, but rather a number of ideas to explore for future development of off-street parking as follows:
  - a. 602 Main Street – Purchase the building, demolish and create public parking.
  - b. First Street – Parallel parking spaces on the north and south sides of Harrison Ave. along First Street.
  - c. Old School parking lot – Purchase and fill with gravel.
  - d. Old School site – Create a parking lot (gravel) on the east side of the property.
  - e. Payant Park – Create a second row of parking spaces on the back end of the Park (east side).
  - f. Property just east of Payant Park (east of the alley) – Purchase portion of two parcels from current owners and develop.
  - g. 528 Harrison Ave. – American Legion Post is for sale. Purchase building and property to create a large public parking lot.
5. Adjourn – Taylor made a motion seconded by McKim to adjourn the meeting at 3:23 pm. Motion carried.
