MINUTES

1. Call to Order – Chairman Randy Schmidt called the meeting to order at 12:10 pm. Committee members in attendance were Mack McKim and Ray Gordon. Also present were President Hilbert Radtke, Public Works Supervisor Dennis Whitton, and Clerk/Treasurer Sara Pullen.
2. Approval of Agenda – Gordon made a motion seconded by McKim to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.
3. Pledge of Allegiance
4. Discussion – Review 5-year street improvement plan and the 5-year maintenance plan. – The Committee toured the streets in the Village and will recommend the following additions to the Street Improvement Plan:
 - a. 2023 – Reconstruct North Cedar Street from Hwy 180 to Butternut including culvert replacement
 - b. 2024 – Reconstruct Jackson Street

The Committee discussed the best use of the additional funds (of the \$21,000 budgeted for maintenance in 2018) after the \$11,800 is spent on Polk Avenue. They recommended crack filling as much as possible starting on the southeast corner of the Village. Streets included are Kenny, Vickie, Orlando, Butternut, Elizabeth, and Van Buren. In addition, there is a small section of Kafka Road that will need to be patched. They will recommend that Van Buren and the alley behind the Post Office be seal coated in 2019.

5. Adjourn – Gordon made a motion seconded by McKim to adjourn the meeting at 2:00 pm. Motion carried.
