Site Requirements:

- 1) Selling shall not take place less than 100 feet from a place where gasoline or volatile liquid is sold.
- 2) Storage of flammable liquids on site is prohibited.
- 3) Smoking is prohibited on site. Must post signs with FIREWORKS – NO SMOKING (letters not less than 4 inches high)
- 4) Minimum of two 5 lb. ABC fire extinguishers in plain view.
- 5) No extension cords or other temporary wiring within 25 feet of any stored fireworks.
- 6) Area where fireworks sold or stored shall be clear of brush, dried vegetation, leaves, and similar combustibles for a distance of 25 feet.

Selling Restrictions:

- 1) People selling must be at least 18 years of age.
- 2) Sale to a person under 18 years of age is prohibited.

Fireworks allowed for sale:

- 1) Toy snake, which contains no mercury.
- 2) Sparkler on a wire or wood stick not exceeding 36 inches in length that is designed to produce audible or visible effects or to produce audible and visible effects.
- 3) Device designed to spray out paper confetti or streamers, which contain less than $\frac{1}{4}$ grain of explosive mixture.
- 4) Fuseless device designed to produce audible or visible effects or audible and visible effects, contains less than $\frac{1}{4}$ grain of explosive mixture.
- 5) Device designed primarily to burn pyrotechnic smoke-producing mixtures at a controlled rate and produces audible or visible effects.
- 6) Cylindrical fountain that consists of one or more tubes that are classified by the federal department of transportation as a Division 1.4 explosive, as defined in 49 CFR 173.50.
- 7) Cone fountain classified by the federal department of transportation as a Division 1.4 explosive, as defined in 49 CFR 173.50.
