

VILLAGE OF WAUSAUKEE PUBLIC NOTICE:
TO ALL VILLAGE OF WAUSAUKEE RESIDENTS/COMMERCIAL
CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER

*****No sump pump shall be connected to any sanitary line leaving a household or business either inside or outside the dwelling. Periodic inspections by utility personnel will be conducted of homes and businesses suspected of illicit connections. This water is to be discharged to the roadside to be carried away as storm water.*****

Sec. 9-2-2 Use of the Public Sewers.

(a) **Sanitary Sewers.** No person(s) shall discharge or cause to be discharged any unpolluted waters as storm water, ground water, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, or cooling water to any sanitary sewer, except storm water runoff from limited areas, which storm water may be polluted at times, may be discharged to the sanitary sewer by permission of the Approving Authority.

No sump pump shall be connected to any sanitary line leaving a household either inside or outside the dwelling. Periodic inspections by utility personnel will be conducted of homes suspected of illicit connections. Violators of this ordinance are subject to fines up to \$2,500 per day that the violation exists!!

Sec. 9-2-9 Violations and Penalties.

(a) **Written Notice of Violation.** Any person found to be violating any provision of this Chapter shall be served by the Village with a written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time for the satisfactory correction thereof. The offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.

(b) **Accidental Discharge.** Any person found to be responsible for accidentally allowing a deleterious discharge into the sewer system which causes damage to the treatment facility and/or receiving body of water shall, in addition to a fine, pay the amount to cover damage, both values to be established by the Approving Authority.

(c) **Continued Violations.** Any person, partnership or corporation, or any officer, agent or employee thereof, who shall continue any violation beyond the aforesaid notice time limit provided shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a forfeiture of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) for each day of violation, together with the costs of prosecution. In default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, said violator shall be imprisoned in the Marinette County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.
