As many of you know, the Village has discussed the possibility of purchasing the former Stephenson National Bank and Trust (SNBT) building for renovation into a community center, expanded library, and Village offices. Returning the building to a productive use that serves the community will help keep the downtown viable. Your Village officials will be holding a public input meeting on June 18, 2019 at 6:00PM at the former SNBT building, 704 Main Street. The meeting will consist of a guided tour and provide a chance to hear feedback from Cedar Corporation's architects who have been retained to conduct a feasibility study. The feasibility study will help the Village make an informed decision regarding the purchase of the building. If the Village decides to pursue possession of the building, any final decision will be dependent on the amount of grant funding it receives from outside sources.
