MINUTES

1. Call to Order – Chair Steve Stumbris called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm. Committee member Darryll Schmidt was in attendance. Also present were Village President Pat Tracy, Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Sara Pullen, and Streets Supervisor Dennis Whitton. Trustee J.J. Feldmann was excused.
The meeting briefly adjourned for the relocation of the meeting to the alley behind Family Dollar. Once on site, business owners Don and Sharon Kantner joined the discussion.
2. Approval of Agenda – Tracy made a motion seconded by Schmidt to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.
3. Pledge of Allegiance
4. Discussion – Drainage issues in the alley immediately west of Main Street (behind Family Dollar). – The Committee discussed the actions taken in the alley in 2018 to try and alleviate the drainage issue at Northwoods Traditions. These included grading on the west side of the alley, and digging a ditch running east and west between the Lund house and Northeast Tax Accounting Service. The Kanter's explained that the actions taken made little to no difference in the drainage.
Stumbris pointed out that the two catch basins on the west side of Family Dollar are not catch basins at all, but rather area drains. These drains only have a 6" inlet running down into the 10" storm pipe which causes a hydraulic jump preventing the water from draining properly due to a lack of air. The Committee will recommend replacing the two area drains with catch basins to alleviate the problem.
5. Adjourn – Schmidt made a motion seconded by Tracy to adjourn the meeting at 5 pm. Motion carried.
